Paramedic Student Physical and Immunization Report

In order to achieve the paramedic curriculum objectives, a student must be able to:

- Assist in lifting and carrying injured and/or ill persons to and from the ambulance.
- Engage in pushing and/or pulling to assist in extrication of a patient pinned beneath and inside a vehicle, and in vehicles with electrical hazards.
- Walk, stand, lift, carry, and balance in excess of 125 pounds without assistance, 250 pounds with assistance) while lifting, pulling, pushing and carrying a patient.
- Stoop, kneel, bend, crouch and crawl on uneven terrain to gain access to a patient.
- Climb stairs, hillsides, and ladders to gain access to a patient.
- Communicate verbally in person, via telephone and radio equipment.
- Work in chaotic environments with loud noises and flashing lights.
- Perform patient assessments, implement treatment, and calculate weight and volume ratios under threatening time constraints.
- Work effectively in low light, confined spaces, extreme environmental conditions and other dangerous environments while remaining calm.
- Perform fine motor movements while in stressful situations and under threatening time constraints.

<p>MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) A Mumps, Rubeola, and Rubella Titer must be drawn and the results attached. A record of the MMR Vaccine will not be accepted as documentation of the required titer. The dates of the titers and the results must be indicated in the appropriate area. INDICATING THE DISEASE PROCESS OR IMMUNIZATION DATES IS NOT ACCEPTABLE</p>	<p>___ Positive antibody titer</p>
<p>Varicella (chicken pox) A Varicella Titer must be drawn and the results attached. A record of the Varicella Vaccine will not be accepted as documentation of the required titer. <p>Hepatitis B All Paramedic students will need documentation that they have received this three (3) part injection series, or at a minimum have started the process. <p>Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap) All Paramedic students must provide proof that they have received a TDAP within the past 10 years. Documentation must be attached to the physical release form.</p>	<p>A. ___ Record of immunization</p>
<p>Influenza All Paramedic students must provide proof that they have received an Influenza immunization within the past 1 year that will remain current during school year.</p>	<p>A. ___ Record of immunization</p>
<p>Tuberculin Skin Tests 2-Step Two consecutive TB Skin Tests are required. The TB Skin tests can be repeated a minimum of three days apart. The dates and results of each TB Skin Test must be attached. The Skin Tests must have been performed within the last three (3) months to be considered a recent test. In the event the results indicate a positive skin test or the student has a history of a positive TB skin test, a chest x-ray is required. Chest X-ray: A recent Chest x-ray is required if a positive TB skin Test is reported or there is a history of a positive TB Skin Test. The chest x-ray must have been completed within the last three (3) months to be considered current.
